Senator Frank Lautenberg will soon introduce TSCA  
reform legislation.

on our health, as well as on green manufacturing and  
chemical industry jobs. A new TSCA could serve as  
a sound chemicals policy that protects public and  
worker health and our environment, while restoring  
safety to U.S. goods in the world market and securing  
manufacturing jobs.

Note to WEC members: There will be a brief business meeting and a vote on the Board of Directors' proposal to increase annual membership dues, which have not increased since 1999. Per the WEC Bylaws Article, Section 4: Annual Membership dues shall be established by the Board of Directors, subject to approval by the membership at a general meeting. Only members in good standing shall be eligible to vote. Good standing shall be defined as a member whose annual dues are currently paid.
